

Post #106 Larned, KS Scholarship Application

Rules for the scholarship:

-Candidate must receive a high school diploma from a Pawnee County high school or a GEDfrom a Pawnee County GED program.

-Candidate must be a child or grandchild (biological, step, or adopted) <u>OR</u> a spouse of a currently serving or Honorably discharged Veteran of the United States Military <u>OR</u> a Veeran that has graduated from a Pawnee County high school or GED program.

-Candidate will have a minimum 2.0 GPA (grade point average).

-Candidate may be seeking scholarship for admission to a college or technical school.

-Scholarship award will be five percent (5%) or endowment, but no less than \$250.00.

-ALR Post #106 Scholarship Endowment Steering Committee will be responsible for selection of recipient(s) and management of the endowment.

Application Requirements:

-Candidate must have the ability to furnish proof of relationship to Veteran (DD214, birth certificate, adoption papers, etc.)

-Candidate must furnish two (2) letters of recommendation.

-Candidate must provide a letter/statement of educational intent.

-Candidate must provide proof of enrollment and acceptance to school, prior to the disbursement of the funds to the recipient.

Please submit the following information to the high school counselor's office:

Please submit a letter containing your name, address, phone number, the name of the relative who honorably served in the US military and your relationship to this individual. Also include your educational intent and a list of extracurricular activities.

Attach a copy of your high school transcript and two letters of recommendation.

If selected, you will be asked to furnish proof of relationship to a Veteran.
