Those students in Barton, Pawnee and Stafford counties interested in the Central Kansas Catbackers scholarships must plan to attend Kansas State University in the Fall of 2022, maintain a 3.0 or better high school G.P.A., and *must* complete the scholarship application in its entirety prior to the filing deadline.

Five (5) \$1,000 scholarships (for graduating high school seniors only) will be awarded based on the quality of responses to the essay questions, short answer questions, and academic merit.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the university over a period of two semesters and may be used to cover tuition, room and board, books, and/or other school supplies.

Please submit your completed application to Central Kansas Catbackers, attn: Scholarship Committee (P.O. Box 1652, Great Bend, Kansas, 67530) by **April 15, 2022**. **Applications received after April 15, 2022 will not be considered.**

The application for this scholarship should be typed and double-spaced. For the application to be complete, you must include ALL of the following:

1. Your full name
2. Your parent(s)/guardian(s) full names
3. Home address
4. City, State, zip
5. E-mail address
6. Phone number
7. Letters of recommendation including name, address, e-mail, and phone number of two (2) persons serving as your reference

Please provide a short answer (300 words or less) to the following essay questions:

1. A brief statement about your college and career plans
2. A brief description of your past employment record
3. A short statement answering the following: As you anticipate your future, what role do you hope to play in making this a better world?

Please answer the following questions:

1. List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated. List them in order of importance to you.
2. List of honors and awards you have received in high school.
3. List your community services, activities, interests, and hobbies.

Additional information needed with your application.

1. Transcript from your High School
2. ACT/SAT score
