Local Scholarships 2022-2023

American Legion Riders Scholarship Post #106- This scholarship was established in 2011 for a child, grandchild or spouse of a Veteran. The candidate must have a 2.0 GPA and plan to attend a technical school or college.

Ralph and Merlene Baird Scholarship- This scholarship will be awarded to a Larned High School Senior who has lost a parent(s) to death, and continued to be active in school functions, and assisted with family financial obligations.

Effie I. Bank & Roy Banks Memorial Scholarship- The recipient of this award is to be a Larned High School graduate who plans on attending an accredited college, university or vocational school in Kansas. The selection is based on scholarship, good citizenship in and out of school, and financial need. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org. Please submit a photo with your application.

Jeff Bland Memorial Scholarship- The recipient of this award is to be a Larned High School graduating senior planning to attend a Kansas college. Preference is given to students majoring in music (although other majors may apply), evidence of character and financial need. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

Tami Borck Memorial Scholarship- This scholarship is for \$5000 given to a student going to Kansas State University. Preference will be given to students who participate in music, theatre, drama, etc. The recipient is expected to achieve a 2.8 GPA. for the first Semester at Kansas State in order to receive 2nd semester tuition stipend.

The Bridge Scholarship- This scholarship is specifically for young women who are high school seniors going into their first year of college. It's called the Bridge Scholarship because it is designed to share education with more driven young women. In out country, women have not had access to education as long as men have. This is a \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester).

Harold Burns Memorial Scholarship- This \$125.00 scholarship will be given to a Pawnee County student who wants to further his/her education. It may be renewed for the 2nd semester with a 2.5 GPA. Preference will be given to Southern Baptist seniors and other students who are active in their own churches.

C.M.E. Escue Chapel- Any graduating senior who plans to continue his/her education at a college of his/her choice and has a GPA of 2.0 or above qualifies for this scholarship. A total of \$400.00 will be awarded- \$200.00 at the beginning of the first, then the second semester.

Dr. Ole and Margerie Cram Memorial Scholarship- The Cram's were active members of the Larned community for 40 years where "doc" was a family practice physician. This scholarship is given to a graduating high school senior who will be attending the University of Kansas or to a current University of Kansas student. Eligible students must be residents of Pawnee County. The value of the scholarship is approximately \$3000.00 per year and may be divided among several students. KU scholarships are renewable for four years as long as all University of Kansas scholarship requirements, including GPA, are met each year by the student scholarship recipient(s). To apply for the scholarship, complete a KU scholarship application at the same time as the KU admissions application and submit both applications together to the KU admissions office. Please check the KU website for the deadline for this scholarship.

Central Kansas Catbackers Scholarship- One of the core values of succeeding in life is Personal Development. Five (5) \$1000 scholarships for graduating high school seniors will be awarded to students in Barton, Pawnee and Stafford counties. Students must plan to attend Kansas State University and maintain a 3.0 or better high school G.P.A.

Cliff and Nina Fell Scholarship- The scholarships will be for the purpose of enabling deserving students to attend a college or university in the State of Kansas and are selected by the Fell Scholarship Committee. Students must be a resident of Pawnee County and graduate from a Pawnee County High School.

First American Baptist Church Scholarship- This is a scholarship to be awarded to a senior graduating from a Pawnee County High School who has an interest in the ministry, mission work or a service occupation. It is a one time award of \$1000.00. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

Fort Larned Lions Memorial Scholarship- Each recipient of this scholarship receives \$500.00 (\$250.00 each semester). Recipient must be a graduating senior of Larned High School with an accumulated GPA of a C+ or higher, display good character, good citizenship, and a firm desire to further his/her education. Student must demonstrate a financial need. Scholarship may be used at any accredited Kansas two- year or four- year college or university, Kansas vocational Technical School or an accredited Kansas professional school.

Doyle Foster Scholarship- This scholarship enables deserving students to attend Fort Hays State University in the area of Education. Students must be a resident of Pawnee County and graduate from Larned High School. The selection is based on the desire to teach, good citizenship in and out of school, and a thousand word essay. Robert "Bobby" Foster Scholarship- This scholarship has been established in honor of Robert Foster. This is a one- time award of \$500.00 to a Larned High School senior with at least a 3.25 GPA planning to major in social work at Kansas State University. Aaron Gathman Memorial Scholarship- \$500.00 for the 1st year of college. \$250.00 for each semester will be awarded for: academic achievement, rank in the top 4th of class, character qualification, and consideration given to previous participation in music activities. Application required.

Hungate/Sivright Memorial Scholarship- This award is presented to a Larned High School senior planning a career in education who has good grades, outstanding character, and is involved in extracurricular activities. The recipient will receive a one- time gift of \$1000.00 to be given in May.

The Dr. John D. Jordaan Scholarships- These scholarships are selected by the Jordaan Foundation committee and are for four years. The scholarships are based on scholarship and need. Students must be a resident of Pawnee County and graduate from a Pawnee County high school.

John Schnack Rotary Trust Scholarship- The Larned Rotary Club will offer 4 scholarships for \$2500 per High School student. Student can attend any college, vocational or higher education program.

KSU Endowed Scholarship- Local Alumni from the Golden Belt will serve on a committee to evaluate eligible criteria and award the annual scholarships. The scholarships are merit-based. The committee will look at academic performance and community service or involvement. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

KU- Pawnee County Alumni Scholarship- This is for students going to KU. Recipients must be a resident of Pawnee County and attend a Pawnee County High School. This scholarship is for one year, and the award is given a semester at a time, depending on satisfactory grades.

Langford Engineering Scholarship- The recipient of this award is to be a Larned High School graduate planning to attend a Kansas or Nebraska University majoring in Engineering. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

Larned First United Methodist Church Scholarship Fund- Criteria for selection are: application information, need, academic, persons who are active participating members of the Larned United Methodist Church. Application must be obtained from the church.

Larned Indian Booster Club Scholarship- Larnd Indian Boosters will award four \$1000 scholarships to four graduating seniors planning on attending either a two or four- year college in the fall. The recipients must have participated in athletics, maintained a good GPA and demonstrated strong leadership skills on and off the field/court.

Laurette Beta Ne Scholarship-

Pawnee County 4-H Foundation Scholarship- To qualify for this scholarship, you must be a high school senior, a current 4-H member in Pawnee County and must have been enrolled in 4-H the previous 3 years. Applications are available through the 4-H Foundation.

Pawnee County Farm Bureau Association Scholarship- To be eligible for this scholarship, the application must be a high school senior in Pawnee County and must be a member of the Pawnee County Farm Bureau Association. Preference will be given to an applicant with a college Ag-related major and must be enrolled in 12 hours college credit per semester. Applications are due to the Pawnee County Farm Bureau office.

PEO Scholarship- PEO Chapter of Larned will award one or more scholarships with total not to exceed \$1800.00 to a deserving high school senior girl based on attitude, scholarship, extracurricular activities, community service, and financial need.

Glenn Presley Memorial Scholarship- Glenn Presley was a fun, caring teacher who taught at Larned High School for 40 years and 2.5 months. His encouraging spirit and positive attitude inspired students daily. This scholarship will be awarded to an LHS graduating senior who plans to attend a college, university or vocational school. The selection is merit based with preference going to industrial arts or education. Candidates must have a 3.0 GPA.

Bob and Roselee Roth Family Scholarship- Bob and Rosalee Roth, long time Larned residents, are offering a scholarship to a graduating Pawnee County high school senior(s) choosing to attend The University of Kansas. The scholarship will be awarded based on a combination of scholastic achievement and financial need. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

Santa Fe Trail Auto Club Automotive Scholarship- The recipient of this scholarship receives \$500.00 (\$250.00 each semester), to attend an accredited college or university, community college, or vo-tech school of your choice. The recipient must be a graduating senior with a cumulative GPA of a C+ or higher, display good character, good citizenship, and a firm desire to further his or her education in the automotive field.

Larry Carr Memorial Scholarship- This scholarship will be for the purpose of enabling a deserving student to continue their education. The recipient of this scholarship receives \$1,000 (\$500/semester). The candidate must have a 2.5 grade point average.

Steve Gillett Memorial Scholarship-This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who has participated in the golf program while in school. The person selected must attend an accredited college, university or vocational school. This is a one-year award of \$500 in memory of Steve Gillett, a 1986 LHS graduate, avid golfer and DCCC golf scholarship recipient. A Memorial Golf Tournament is held each August by friends of Steve at the Larned Golf Course. A scholarship application is required.

Roy Peter Bach Memorial Scholarship- Applicants must be a current senior residing in Pawnee County and enrolled at a Pawnee County High school (Larned High School or Pawnee Heights High School) who has been accepted or anticipates being accepted into and accredited four-year university, two-year junior college, vocational college, or vocational training program. Preference will be given to vocational fields of study, including agricultural, automotive and diesel mechanics, electrical, health fields, etc.

VFW Scholarship- Applicants shall be graduating high school seniors or have the equivalent of a high school diploma. Applicant must provide the eligible VFW Post Number: that is the VFW Post or VFW Auxiliary that the applicant's eligibility is actively affiliated with the State of Kansas, or was so at the time of his/her death.

Larned Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship- This scholarship will be awarded to a Larned High school senior who is active in 4-H in Pawnee County. Applicants must have been active in 4-H for a minimum of 4 years. Applicants must be majoring in either nursing or business and planning to attend Fort Hays State University or Barton Community College with a clear indication of going to FHSU to complete a bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to students who have completed 12 or more college credit hours during high school. Application is available at www.goldenbeltcf.org.

Innovative Livestock Services Scholarship-This scholarship is only available through the company.

H and H Scholarship- This Scholarship was started to give back to the community and encourage students to pursue business and construction trades. Eligible students must be attending college with intentions to earn a Business Degree or a Construction Trade School Degree.

Larned Music Club- A scholarship is awarded to a high school graduate from Pawnee County who has declared a major or minor in music. THe recipient shall receive \$600 per semester for up to four years, and must maintain a grade point average of 3.0. The recipient is chosen through audition and thereafter shall perform at least once a year for the Larned Music Club at a mutually convenient time.

Larned Noon Lions Memorial Scholarship- On behalf of the Larned Noon Lions Club, will award \$500 to two LHS graduating seniors who will be attending a Junior College, Vocational, Trade School or University. Preference will be given to students who maintain a solid GPA, have performed at least 50 hours of community service, and have demonstrated strong leadership skills throughout their academic, community, and social experience.
